What has the Co-Production Partnership been doing?

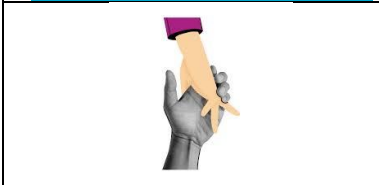
	<p>We have supported people who use home care support services and carers be part of choosing which organisations should provide these services locally.</p>
	<p>We worked with Bradford Council to make sure that people who use services and carers were properly involved in this. This meant making sure that all the information could be understood by everyone.</p>
	<p>We have also supported people attend a meeting about Changing Places Toilets. These are highly accessible toilets for people with complex care needs.</p>
	<p>People said that making sure that the facilities are kept clean and in good condition is really important. It would be good if they can be available in more of the big parks in the District.</p>
	<p>We have started to do training with adults with learning disabilities to be peer researchers. This means that people with learning disabilities will find out what other people with learning disabilities think about services. We are doing this work with People First Keighley and Craven.</p>
	<p>We are doing this work with People First Keighley and Craven.</p>
	<p>We hope that the peer researchers will find out what people who use the New Choices day services want when these change.</p>

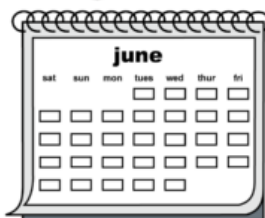
