- We have booked BSL interpreters.

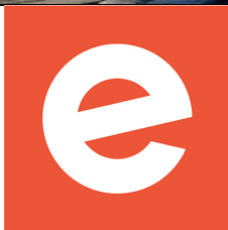
If you have other access needs please tell us when you book your place.
