There are information sessions on this which will be held on Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> February, either 10 – 12.30 or 1 -3.30.

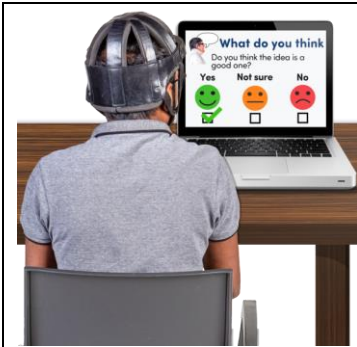
